The Ivins Youth Council gives youth a voice on city issues, an understanding of how government works, and an opportunity to provide a service to the community showcasing the knowledge, skill, and dedication of youth in Ivins. Serving on Youth Councils also looks good on college applications.

Activities include: Leadership Retreat; education on Parliamentary Procedure and Rules of Order; create a youth event for Heritage Days; make presentations at the Ivins City Council about youth issues; attend the State Legislature; education on City Government; and more.



Youth Council members are required to have their own transportation to attend events in Washington County. (Transportation, food, and accommodation provided for the annual trip to the State Capitol.)

The Youth Council has regular meetings at City Hall on the first and third Wednesday of most months from 5pm to 6pm (minimal summer activities). Members are required to attend at least 75% of these meetings and other community and service events.



The only out-of-pocket expense members pay for is their cost for gas for trips in Washington County. Members receive a polo shirt with the Youth Council logo to wear at meetings and community events.

Each meeting is vital because the members work with the Mayor and City Council to address local issues important to youth and brainstorm how to improve Ivins for today's youth and future generations. Participation in community service activities is expected.
